- Created a new set of programs to calculate charges for toll work and create the sales orders to invoice the mills for slitting and storage charges.
- Created interfaces for AP to upload credit card purchase data from the bank website for credit card payments. This interface used the IFS on the AS/400 to handle upload and conversion of CSV files for processing into the JDE using the AP batch load program.
